Joyful Praise Choir (Children 4 years old by 9/1/11 to grade 1) — Tim Moe, Director **Wednesdays 6-7 PM**. This choir prepares children to be lifelong participants in the music and worship of the church. Singing, music, hymn learning, bible, and worship skills are taught through a variety of activities.

Covenant Choir (Children grades 2-5) - Susan Read, Director. **Wednesdays 6-7 PM**. Children grow in their understanding of music, skills, singing, instruments, hymnody, bible, worship, and worship leadership skills. Regularly participation in worship, and working together as a team is very important.



Agape Youth Choir (grades 6-12) Tim Moe, Director- **Sundays 4:30-5:45**.

'Opening Night' rehearsal Sunday, Sept. 12th This choir regularly serves in worship, works on music reading, singing in multiple parts, using good vocal technique, and choral tone. They do outreach through multi-state tours and local appearances, and join with other church youth choir members from around the country for choir festivals. This coming year will culminate with a mission/outreach tour to Virginia and Washington DC, and a production of the musical, “Celebrate the Vision”.



Chancel Choir (Adults – college and up) Tim Moe, Director - **Wednesdays 7:30-9:00**. This choir is the nucleus of our choir music ministry, providing an example of faithfulness, and weekly worship leadership. They prepare and perform the best choral music in a wide variety of styles and traditions, as well as performing larger choral works with instrumentalists. They are challenged to grow spiritually, musically, and socially, Membership is open to all, regardless of experience.
