**Intergenerational Trip to Calvin  
Center March 30-April 4, 2012**

Want to make a difference in someone's life? Join us as we answer Christ's call to care for the "least of these," in our world.

**To:** Calvin Center, Hampton, GA

**Dates:** Fri., March 30 (5pm)-Wed., April 4 (5pm)

**Participants:** Must be a current 6th grader-adult member of our congregation &/or youth group.

**Required Preparation Meetings:** Each participant is expected to attend 2 preparatory meetings. 1) Feb. 19 from Noon-1:30pm and 2) Mar. 18 from Noon-1:30pm

**The Work:** We will team up with Calvin Center (A Presbyterian Camp and Conference of the PC USA) for daily off-site work projects and on-site worship and recreation. Through an established connection with *Meals on Wheels*, elderly home owners are identified that need help with home renovations. Typical projects consist of painting, simple carpentry, yard work, and cleaning. In addition to repairing the homes of some very deserving people, you have the opportunity to connect with the homeowners and hear their amazing life stories. Seeing people of all ages come together to build, reconstruct, listen and talk is a very powerful way to live out Christ's call for us to be people of word and deed.

**Cost:** \$190/person (Please make checks out to: OAPC)  
A non-refundable \$90 deposit is due by January 29.  
The balance of \$100 is due by February 26.
