### Children and Youth will grow in faith, have fun, & change the world...

**Infants-1s:** Nursery Care; **2s:** A stationary class that will briefly cover all five of our stories through play, storytelling, and crafts. **For children of Volunteers & Participants.**

**3s & 4s:** A stationary class for our 3-4year olds will cover the parable of The Sower through play, storytelling, crafts, and outside play.
